Tuition fee lifeline for Northumbria student

A Northumbria University student has secured a £25,000 tuition fee lifeline and a guaranteed job on completion of her degree.

Computing student Danielle Walsh will have her annual tuition fees paid by Gateshead-based electric vehicle component maker Sevcon under its innovative student bursary scheme.

Danielle is the first Northumbria University student to win a place on the Sevcon scheme. She will take up a software engineering post when she

completes her studies.

Danielle, 20, is currently in the second year of BSc (Hons) Ethical Hacking for Computer Security at Northumbria University.

She said: “I was extremely overwhelmed and happy to hear I had made an impression at Sevcon and now I have a chance to work with an amazing company and develop my programming skills to an exceptional standard.

“The securing of my future both financially and as a valuable employee is truly wonderful and I will be eternally grateful to Sevcon.”
