## Northumbria law student crowned first Apprentice of the Year for the region

A law student from Northumbria University's first-ever <u>Solicitor Higher</u> <u>Apprenticeship</u> cohort has been named Apprentice of the Year at the highly prestigious Northern Law Awards.

Originally from Leeds, Saffron is in her sixth and final year of the programme at Northumbria, studying part-time whilst working at Newcastle-based law firm <u>Sintons</u>.

<u>The Northern Law Awards</u> celebrate the great wealth of legal talent within the region. Saffron achieved the title 'Apprentice of the Year' - a new category which debuted at this year's ceremony at St James' Park.

In a category with a shortlist of exceptional calibre, Saffron showed excellent legal skills over a range of disciplines, a proven track record of academic ability, and significant personal and professional development.
