Prestigious lecture comes live at Northumbria

to host a live screening of this year's Garner Lecture.

Students and members of the public are being invited to view the lecture by the Rt Hon Lord Carnwath of Notting Hill C.V.O, a Justice of the UK Supreme Court, at lecture theatre 003, City Campus East, Northumbria Law School on Tuesday November 19 from 5:30pm.

Held in association with the Planning and Environment Bar Association, the Garner Lecture is one of the UK's leading environmental law events.

Kevin Kerrigan, Executive Dean of the Law School at Northumbria University, said: "We are delighted to be hosting a live screening of such a prestigious event in the environmental law calendar, especially as this year will be the 25th anniversary of the Garner Lecture. "Lord Carnwath is an eminent legal figure having been a Lord Justice of Appeal since September 2001 and a Judge of the High Court, Chancery Division, from 1994. He was Chairman of the Law Commission for England and Wales from February 1999 until July 2002."
